COMFORT QUILTS

We are trying something new this year. Each month, a donation of a quilt or joey bag, and maybe a couple of pillowcases, gets your name in a drawing for that month. A fat quarter bundle (8-10) from local quilt shop including their card in case someone would want to get more fabric to make a quilt, is being donated by a group of generous members.
