April is black/white and the last one is any color batiks.



The rules are very simple. NO buying fabric. Use your stash to complete a block (pattern provided) each month. If a block is submitted your name will be entered in a drawing to win all of the blocks.

The block March is a Scrap Buster block using any variation of light/medium and dark. It is a very good way to use up the leftovers from jelly rolls. The pattern is posted on the Facebook website and in this newsletter.


